

JUDY GENSHAFT HONORS COLLEGE GRAND OPENING

The University of South Florida celebrated the grand opening of the Judy Genshaft Honors College on May 12.

This modern five-story, 85,000-square-foot building is dedicated to supporting USF's top undergraduates and will welcome its first class of students this summer. The new facility, located across from the Yuengling Center along USF Genshaft Drive, features a range of innovative spaces, including open-layout classrooms, 39 learning lofts, and dedicated art, food and culture, music, and technology studios.

The project was largely financed by philanthropic donations, notably a \$20 million gift from former USF President Judy Genshaft and her husband, Steven Greenbaum.

Student success is expected to grow as the new building will offer more opportunities for student engagement, which links directly to stronger academic achievements.
