## Road Rage Incident

At approximately 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, Jan. 4, the University of South Florida Police Department was made aware of a road rage incident that occurred on the USF Tampa campus. The two vehicles involved eventually ended up at the LeRoy Collins Garage, where the driver of one vehicle brandished a firearm while in his vehicle and pointed it in the direction of the driver of the second vehicle before driving away. No injuries were reported.

USFPD, with the assistance of the Temple Terrace Police Department, went to the suspect's house and placed him under arrest without further incident.

There is no ongoing threat to the university community. The matter remains under investigation.

Possession of a firearm on campus is a violation of Florida law.

Students, faculty and staff are always encouraged to remain vigilant, aware of their surroundings and immediately report suspicious activity by calling 911.
