



# THE RAYMOND & SIMONE MIKLOS ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

*This prestigious scholarship was established in 2002 by Raymond Miklos to honor his beloved wife, Simone. Simone attended the University of South Florida and lived a full and joyous life. Ray's hope was to support and encourage other young students from France to emulate Simone's passion for learning and living. Simone cherished her memories as a student and loved sharing her French culture with her classmates and friends.*

The Miklos Scholarship is awarded to 2-3 top scholars at USF annually who meet the criteria and are selected by a committee on the basis of merit, application, and essay. Selected students will receive an award of \$2,000 to \$3,000 per semester, which is renewable for up to 6 semesters if all of the qualifications continue to be met.

**If you meet the following qualifications, we urge you to apply for this funding:**

- a. French heritage: must have proof of French citizenship and birthplace in France
- b. Current full-time, degree-seeking undergraduate student at USF who has completed at least 30 credit hours
- c. GPA of 3.0 or above
